





Jaca is a vibrant city that combines modernity, tradition, history, breathtaking landscapes, and a unique monumental heritage.


Its proximity to the winter resorts of Astún and Candanchú makes it the capital of snow, and its streets are lively all year round

















The building consolidates Jaca's status as the capital of ice sports and is distinguished by its toroidal dome structure, composed of a membrane alternating opaque structures, glass, and steel.

It is the only facility in Spain with two ice rinks, one of Olympic dimensions and another for recreational use. The venue can hold up to 3,579 spectators.











ASTÚN



The ski resort, inaugurated in 1976, is located in the heart of the Aragonese Pyrenees, just 30 km from Jaca.

Bordering France, it offers 50 km of ski slopes and a variety of additional activities, such as sled descents, equipment testing, excursions, gastronomic experiences, and much more.











CANDANCHÚ

Candanchú was Spain's first ski resort, inaugurated in 1927. It is known as "the most alpine resort in the Pyrenees," characterized by rugged mountains and steep peaks.

Located just a few kilometers from the French border, it is one of the most special places for skiing in Spain.


It has a strong family-friendly tourism appeal and offers a high transport capacity (26,000 people per hour) thanks to its 25 ski lifts.






